Applicants should be well versed in responsible event planning to ensure successful philanthropic fundraisers and activities.

In addition, she may be called upon to:

- Emphasize the role of "School & College Readiness" as Phi Sigma Sigma's philanthropic identity.
- Work with collegiate chapter members to promote a strong partnership between chapters, the Fraternity and the Foundation.
- Guide collegiate chapters through strategic planning and needs assessment to create programs and direct efforts in an intentional way.
- Support the chapter's efforts to establish and maintain a relationship with community partner(s).
- Coach collegiate chapter philanthropy chairman in responsible planning and facilitation of activities with community partner(s) and fundraising events.
- Participate in trainings as needed.
- Fully participate in all committee conference calls, basecamp forums and via email.
- Work in this role will be continuous throughout the academic year.
- Commit to serving in the specialist role through May 2022.
- Pay alumnae dues.
